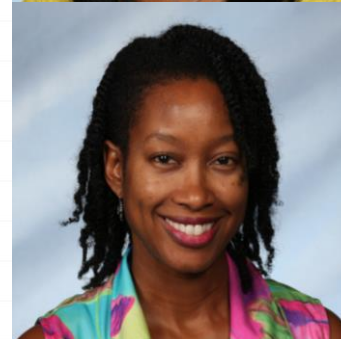

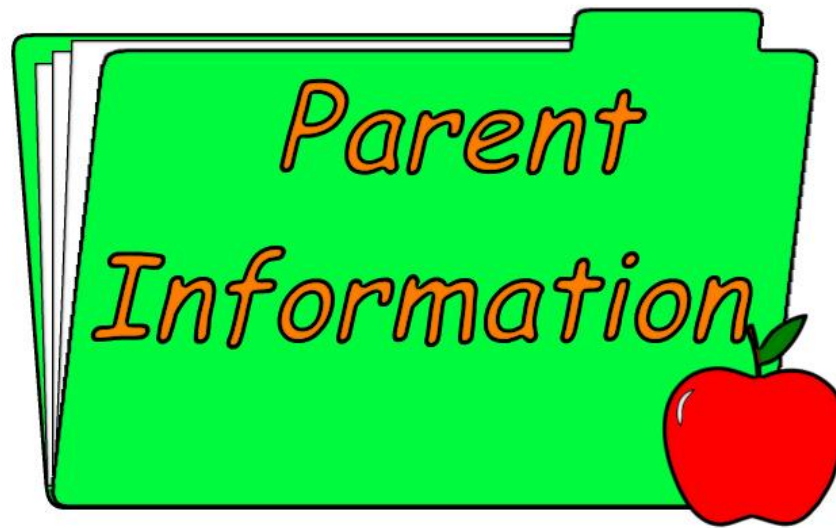

- **Use a planner to stay organized**



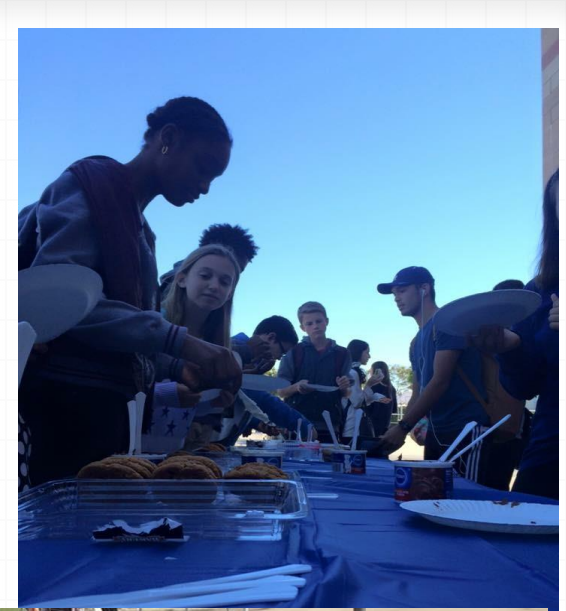


Transitional Programs

 - Mentoring relationships

Friends of LACES is the parent group for LACES. FOL works with Principal Boger, teachers, staff and fellow parents to support the LACES students. o **Fundraisers & Donations**

Parents donate in the fall to the Annual Giving Campaign (AGC). This is the largest fundraiser for FOL. *Spring Gala* is in March/April. Parents are asked to donate items for the drawings/silent auction, attend & bid. *LACES Big Eat*- Two family dinner nights a year.
