
# Los Angeles Center for Enriched Studies HIGH SCHOOL (Grades 9-12) SUMMER READING LIST 2010

Students need to read the **\*mandatory book in boldface** for their grade level. Students and parents are responsible for obtaining appropriate book/books for the incoming English class. Please check your local library and bookstore. In September, students will discuss the book in their English classes and there will be an assessment. In order to ensure that students come to class in September ready to discuss and write about what they have read, students should consider: marking the text if the book is their own to record comments, questions, and highlight unfamiliar vocabulary; using post-it notes if they borrow the book and saving these notes for future reference. It is highly recommended that students read an additional book from the "101 Great Books Recommended for College Bound Readers" following this page. Reading helps students succeed in language arts classes. Students taking AP English Language and AP English Literature will have a separate reading list and writing assignment.
